## Course Overview

This NCFE Level 3 Diploma for the Early Years Workforce (Early Years Educator) will prepare you to become an Early Years educator or practitioner, enabling you to work with children from birth to 5 years in an early years setting.

## Entry Requirements

You must have either a relevant Level 2 qualification, or experience in an Early Years setting for a minimum of 1 year. Your level of English or Arabic (if course taken in Arabic) should enable you to complete verbal and written assignments.

You should have an email account & access to a laptop with internet connection.

## How long will this course take?

From 12 to 18 months, depending on your level of experience.

- Teaching hours: 3 hour session every other week (face to face or online).
- Placement hours: 350 hours, with different age groups, over the duration of the course.

## What will you learn?

The Diploma is structured around the following themes:

- Health and well-being
- Legislation relating to the safeguarding, protection and welfare of children
- Play, development and learning for school readiness
- Professional development

Through this course, you will:

- Gain a comprehensive understanding of children's development from birth to 5 years of age.
- Learn about the health, safety, nutritional and physical needs of children.
- Know about the theories and regulatory frameworks for early years practitioners in the UK and in the UAE.
- Be able to conduct observations and assessment of children.
- Be able to plan appropriate learning opportunities to support children's overall development, based on observations and assessment.
- Be able to provide an enabling environment for each individual child.
- Be able to define your own professional development plan for continuous growth.
